

Attending an immunisation session

Please bring your Medicare card and Childhood Health Record Book with you.

You should arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the session finishing as there is a 15 minute observation period after immunisations.

Always read the pre-immunisation checklist and inform the nurse of any concerns prior to immunisation.

Infant immunisations

Children can be immunised from 6 weeks of age. When attending your child's first immunisation session, you will be asked to complete a consent form after discussion with the nurse.

No jab, no play/No jab, no pay

Children can only be enrolled in kindergarten and childcare with proof that they are fully immunised for their age, or have commenced an immunisation catch up program. Some tax and childcare benefits may be withheld by the Government if your child is not fully immunised.

Incomplete immunisation history

If your child's immunisation records are not up to date contact Council's Immunisation Service and we will assist in obtaining a school entry immunisation certificate and/or updating your child's immunisations. Catch-up immunisations are only provided at appointment sessions.

6 months	Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, Polio, Hepatitis B, Haemophilus Influenza B
1 year	Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Pneumococcal, Meningococcal ACWY
18 months	Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Varicella Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, Haemophilus Influenza B
4 years	Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, Polio
Year 7 program	Human Papilloma Virus, Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis
Year 10 program	Meningococcal ACWY
15 years and over ATSI	Pneumococcal, Influenza
15-49 years with medical risk	Pneumococcal, Influenza
65 years and over	Pneumococcal, Influenza
70-79 years	Shingles (Herpes Zoster)
