- 1 GATEWAY ENTRANCES  
Avenue planting along Farnsworth Ave and feature planting at key intersections / entry points
- 2 MARIBYRNONG BLVD ENTRY DRIVE  
Traffic calming with roundabout at entrance and improved circulation.
- 3 MOORE STREET GATEWAY  
Major gateway signage at Moore St entry
- 4 RIVER EDGE PICNIC AREAS  
Additional sheltered barbecue and picnic facilities along river edge
- 5 ENTRY PLAZA & DREW WALK CONNECTION  
Complete formal axis and connection to river
- 6 JETTY / PONTOON  
New pontoon for increased recreational use of river and access to Footscray Park
- 7 NEW ROTUNDA (LONG TERM)  
A rotunda for gatherings, weddings and events, to replace existing stage
- 8 EAST CARPARK  
Existing carpark improved and connected to path network.
- 9 SHARED PATH CONNECTION  
Connect Ballarat Road bike lane with river trail shared path. Potential to also widen Ballarat Rd footpath.
- 10 HERITAGE GARDEN PATH CONNECTIONS  
Improved path connections between the Gardens and river trail.
- 11 BALLARAT ROAD PARK ENTRANCES  
Improved entries from Ballarat Road including path connections, ramp upgrades, fencing, signage and way finding.
- 12 BALLARAT ROAD LOOKOUT (LONG TERM)  
Potential to convert existing public toilet to a platform/shelter with seating
- 13 FORMER MILLS CLOSE DEPOT  
Provide entry to heritage gardens and enhanced visitor facilities and amenities
- 14 WOMENS FOOTBALL AND JUNIOR FOOTBALL ACADEMY  
Pavilion, seating and fields with openable fencing with enhanced energy efficiency lighting
- 15 HENRY TURNER NORTH CARPARK (LONG TERM)  
Extend existing carpark to the north
- 16 MOUNTAIN BIKE FACILITIES  
Pump Track (as per Quarry Park Masterplan)
- 17 MEDIAN BOULEVARD PLANTING  
Extend Palm Planting along Ballarat Rd
- 18 EXISTING PAVILION  
Investigate new pavilion options
- 19 CIRCUIT WALKING PATH  
2.5 - 3m Circuit walking path around sports fields
- 20 REGIONAL PLAYSPACE  
All-abilities Playspace and Public Toilet
- 21 GATEWAY LAWN  
Inviting green space at eastern edge of park
- 22 IMPROVED INTERFACES  
Improved interfaces with Vic Uni buildings and pedestrian points with increased landscaping
- 23 COMMUNITY FESTIVALS AND CELEBRATION SPACE
- 24 INTERPRETATION AND INTERACTIVITY  
Enhanced heritage interpretation throughout park  
Wifi interactivity and smart lighting

Major gateway signage at Moore St entry



**JETTY / PONTOON**  
New pontoon for increased recreational use of river and access to Footscray Park



**COMMUNITY FESTIVAL AND CELEBRATIONS**  
Continued use of Footscray Park for premiere community events and festivals



**BALLARAT ROAD LOOKOUT (LONG TERM)**  
Potential to convert existing public toilet to a platform/shelter with seating



**RIVER EDGE PLANTING**  
Enhanced native landscaping along the rivers edge



**CIRCUIT WALKING PATH**  
2.5 - 3m Circuit walking path around sports fields



**REGIONAL PLAYSPACE**  
All-abilities Playspace and Public Toilet



**IMPROVING THE EDGE CONDITION OF VICTORIA UNIVERSITY**  
Work in collaboration with VU to create active edge conditions through future development of their site



**PICNIC FACILITIES**  
Sheltered barbecue and picnic nodes along river edge





**INTERPRETATION AND INTERACTIVITY**  
Enhanced interpretation based on the natural and cultural heritage significance of the park



**MEDIAN BOULEVARD PLANTING**  
Extend Palm Planting (Livistona Australis - Cabbage Palm) along Ballarat Rd

Enhanced visitor facilities, hospitality offerings and views across Footscray Park
