Standard Conditions

The permit to keep more than three animals is issued pursuant to City of Maribyrnong's General Purposes Local Law 2015, Part 15.

A full extract may be obtained at www.maribyrnong.vic.gov.au

- **Noise and Smell**
An occupier of any land on which any animal is kept must not allow any noise; or smell to emanate from the animal which interferes with the reasonable comfort or convenience of persons who occupy adjacent or nearby land.
- That you as the applicant, or any of the animals are not convicted of any offence under the Domestic Animals Act 1994.
- Should one of animal die, or you wish to replace it, or in the circumstances where the number of animals exceeds the existing permit, a new application must lodged with Council.
- The number and type of animals kept on the property does not exceed that allowed by this permit.
- That should any of the above conditions not be observed Council may withdraw this permit at any time.
- Various conditions may be included by the Authorised Officer, who will discuss these with you.
