The land affected by the application is located at:	Bus Stop 31115, adjacent to 303 Williamstown Road Yarraville
The application is for a permit to:	Construct and display a double-sided electronic promotion sign

Description of the Proposal:	<p>The proposal is briefly summarised as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Construction and display of a double-sided, electronic promotion sign. • Display area to be 935mm in width by 1.64m in height; • Overall display area of 1.54sqm on each side; • Displayed within southern panel of existing bus shelter structure; • Set back from carriageway by 1.8m. • The application seeks to replace the existing static sign with a double-sided electronic sign with a dwell time of 10 seconds. The proposed sign is typical of bus shelters across Victoria.

The Responsible Authority must make a copy of every objection available for any person to inspect free of charge until the end of the period during which an application may be made for review of a decision on the application.
