Conditions of issue

- 1. Applications must be submitted at least one month prior to the event.
- 2. A copy of the public liability insurance policy or a certificate from the company that is erecting the sign must accompany each application with a minimum amount of \$10 million. This policy must remain valid for the period of the permit and must indemnify Maribyrnong City Council.
- 3. Signs must be properly and professionally affixed to approved locations only.
- 4. A copy of the sign's artwork and description must be submitted with this application.
- 5. Boards must be removed within three (3) calendar days following the event or if otherwise directed by the permit.
- 6. Signs must not contain any prescribed fee such as entrance fees or costs associated with entrance.
- 7. Permit only issues to a local educational, cultural, social or recreational event, which is for a non-commercial purpose. This does not include signage associated with membership drives and enrolments etc. The community event must be held within the Municipality with the proposed signage displayed for a limited time.
