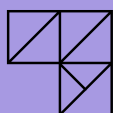

Discover the art of Kokedama and create your own beautiful Japanese moss ball plant to take home. A fun way to connect with nature and learn a new gardening technique.

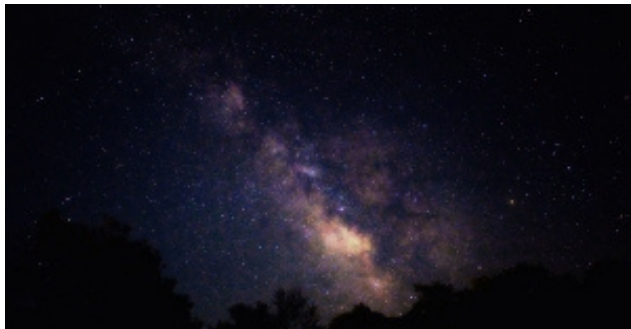


White Card Training

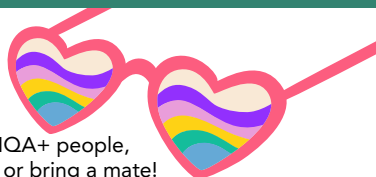
Queer Social

Drop In

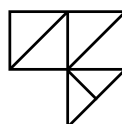
