Not in any bin: Electronic waste or power cords, batteries of any kind, chemicals or hazardous waste, building waste, soil or rubble. Scan the QR code to find out where to dispose of these items.



Food and garden organics

✓ Allowed

- ✓ Food scraps
- ✓ Citrus, onion and garlic
- ✓ Seafood, meat and bones
- ✓ Bread, pasta and rice
- ✓ Garden waste
- ✓ Dairy and eggs
- Keep your bin out of direct sunlight.
- Freeze smelly scraps like fish, shells, and bones in a container until bin night.
- Line your caddy with newspaper to absorb liquid.
- Give your bin a seasonal rinse.





O Not allowed

"Compostable" products, kitty litter or animal droppings, nappies, soil or rocks, plastic bags, textiles, teabags and coffee pods.

Mixed recycling

✓ Allowed

- ✓ Plastics numbered ✓ Glass bottles 1, 2 or 5 and jars
- ✓ Steel and ✓ Paper and aluminium cans cardboard
- ✓ Aluminium foil
- Remove all food before recycling your containers and remove their lids.
- For a comprehensive list of proper item disposal scan the QR code on the back of this pamphlet.



Not allowed

Plastics numbered 3 (PVC), 4, 6 (Polystyrene) or 7, soft plastics, textiles, teabags and coffee pods, disposable plates and cutlery, aerosol cans, CO2 canisters, batteries, tetrapaks.

Not allowed

Batteries, electronic waste, plastics numbered 1, 2 or 5, steel, aluminium cans, aluminium foil, glass bottles, jars, paper and cardboard.
